A BYLAW to authorize the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

. WHEREAS Council did by Bylaw No. 7256 establish the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund.

AND WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the said fund of \$27,294,409.00 as at the 29th day of December 1982.

AND WHEREAS there is in the said reserve fund as at the 29th day of December 1982 monies designated for housing and related projects in the amount of \$4,119,385.00.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$124,000.00 of the said amount for the preparation of a computer data base for housing studies.

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs has been obtained.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND BYLAW NO. 1, 1983.
- 2. The Council does hereby appropriate from the said reserve fund the sum of \$124,000.00 of the monies designated for housing and related projects for the purpose of preparing a computer base for housing studies.

Should any of the said sum of \$124,000.00 remain 3. unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit made, of the said reserve fund.
