
A BYLAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic  
Portions of Road

WHEREAS those portions of road shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plans 992, 1128, 2686 and 3037 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BYLAW NO. 1, 1983.
2. Those portions of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as those portions of road in District Lots 171 and 53, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plans 992, 1128, 2686 and 3037 containing by admeasurement 1.4895 ha, 907 m<sup>2</sup>, 1.3724 ha, 0.6300 ha, 400 m<sup>2</sup>, 0.1075 ha and 183 m<sup>2</sup> shown outlined on the plan prepared by Ian C. MacDonald, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 4th day of March, 1983, a copy of which is annexed hereto, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portions of road more particularly described in section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
