BYLAW NO. 8079

A BYLAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic  
Portions of Road

WHEREAS those portions of road shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 1993 and by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby Bylaw No. 2051 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BYLAW NO. 2, 1983.

2. Those portions of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as those portions of road in District Lot 153, Group 1, New Westminster District

(1) dedicated by the deposit of Plan 1993; and

(2) dedicated by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby Bylaw No. 2051,

containing by admeasurement 0.3790 ha and 0.1172 ha shown outlined on the plan prepared by Dieter Soukup, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 28th day of January 1983 a copy of which is annexed hereto, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portions of road more particularly described in section 2(1) hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
