BYLAW NO. 8097

A BYLAW concerning illuminated signs at
neighbourhood convenience stores

The Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby

ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY SIGN BYLAW
AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 1983.

2. Section 1 of Schedule II of BURNABY SIGN BYLAW 1972
is amended by adding thereto immediately after subsection (4)
the following subsection (5):

"(5) One illuminated business or identification
canopy or facia sign fronting on each street
that bounds the property on which is located
an existing retail store catering to the day-
to-day shopping needs of the residents of the
local neighbourhood."

3. Section 2(2) of the said Schedule II is repealed and
the following substituted therefor:

"(2) No illuminated sign shall be permitted other
than those at existing retail stores catering
to the day-to-day shopping needs of the
residents of the local neighbourhood; and the
total area of such a permitted illuminated
sign shall not exceed a ratio of one square
foot of sign area for each lineal foot of
street frontage of the building to which the
sign is attached."
