

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8130

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 6191, being
Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound and Animal
Regulation Bylaw 1972.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS
as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND
AND ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW 1972, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1983.

2. Section 3(1) of Bylaw No. 6191 is repealed and the
following substituted therefor:

"3. (1) Every person within the Municipality who owns a dog
shall

(a) have a valid and subsisting licence for the said
dog;

(b) procure the said licence upon application in
writing to the Licence Inspector of the
Corporation upon the form provided and upon
paying the prescribed licence fee, namely:

- (i) for each unneutered male dog \$26.00
- (ii) for each neutered male dog \$10.00
- (iii) for each unspayed female dog \$26.00
- (iv) for each spayed female dog \$10.00"

3. Clause (c) of section 5 is repealed and the following
substituted therefor:

"(c) The penalty for a violation of clause (a) of section 5
shall be \$27.00 if the dog is licensed and \$43.00 plus
licence fee if the dog is unlicensed."

4. Schedule "A" is amended by striking out items (1) and (2) and substituting therefor the following:

- "(1) For each licensed dog \$27.00
- (2) For each unlicensed dog \$43.00 plus
licence fee"

5. Item (1) of Schedule "B" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

- "(1) For each dog \$3.50 per day
or part of a day"

6. Item (4) of Schedule "C" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

- "(4) Notwithstanding anything in this
schedule contained, licensed
veterinarians and other agencies
approved by Council shall pay for
the disposal of animals and
poultry \$.18 per pound
min. charge of \$4.25
- (5) For each dead body of a cat or dog ... \$.18 per pound
min. charge of \$4.25"

7. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January 1984.
