THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BYLAW NO. 8134

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 3065, being the Burnaby Club Regulation Bylaw 1950

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CLUB REGULATION BYLAW 1950, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1983.
- 2. Section 2 of Bylaw No. 3065, as enacted by Bylaw No. 8009, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "2. No club shall operate or carry on business unless it holds a valid and subsisting licence from the Municipality. The fee for a first licence shall be \$440.00 and the fee for a renewal licence shall be \$250.00."
- 3. Section 4 of Bylaw No. 3065, as enacted by Bylaw No. 8009, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - Every club carrying on business within the Municipality shall appoint a manager who shall, before entering upon his duties, be in possession of a valid and subsisting licence. For a first licence the fee shall be \$125.00 and for a renewal licence the fee shall be \$75.00."
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January, 1984.
