## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BYLAW NO. 8135

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 1914, being the Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine Bylaw No. 1946

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY AUTOMATIC VENDING MACHINE BYLAW 1946, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1983.
- Subsection (1) of of section 8A of Bylaw No. 1914, as 2. enacted by Bylaw No. 8010, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "8A. (1)The fee payable for a licence under this Bylaw shall be:
    - (a) for a newspaper vending machine ..... \$21.00
    - (b) for a coin-operated washer, dryer or dry-cleaning machine located in residential premises containing more than 2 dwelling units..... \$10.50
    - for a machine that sells goods (c) or services for 25 cents or less ..... \$ 6.25 for more than 25 cents and less than 76 cents ..... \$21.00
    - (d) for an amusement or recreation vending machine ..... \$46.50
- This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January, 1984.
