BYLAW NO. 8148

A BYLAW to designate Seaforth Schoolhouse as a Municipal heritage site pursuant to Section 11 of the Heritage Conservation Act.

WHEREAS the school known as Seaforth Schoolhouse was erected on the corner of Government Road and Piper Avenue in 1922 and was in continuous use until June 1983;

AND WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of School District No. 41 have donated the building with the intention that it form part of the historical display at Heritage Village Museum;

AND WHEREAS the building has been relocated to a site on the grounds of Heritage Village Museum at 4900 Deer Lake Avenue in Burnaby, where it will be restored to its original condition and opened for display to the public;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY HERITAGE BUILDING 1. BYLAW 1983.

2. The Council does hereby designate Seaforth Schoolhouse as a heritage building.
