BYLAW NO. 8198

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$25,810,650.60 as at the 25th day of March, 1984, calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS there is in the said Reserve Fund as at the 25th day of March, 1984 monies designated for housing and related projects in the amount of \$4,162,546.55.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$130,000.00 of the said balance for the continuation of the Residential Neighbourhood Environment Study, for which amounts of \$41,250.00 was appropriated by Bylaw No. 8116 and \$124,000.00 was appropriated by Bylaw No. 8021.

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs has been obtained.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 4, 1984.
- 2. The sum of \$130,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the continuation of the Residential Neighbourhood Environment Study.
- 3. Should any of the said sum of \$130,000.00 plus interest earned remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
