BYLAW NO. 8349


A BYLAW to stop up and close to traffic portions of road.

WHEREAS those portions of road shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 1852 are no longer required for road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BYLAW NO. 2, 1985.
2. That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as all that portion of road in Block 6, South Half of District Lot 74, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by the deposit of Plan 1852 containing by admeasurement 938.9 m² as shown outlined on the explanatory plan prepared by B.S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 25th day of April 1985, a copy of which is annexed hereto, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portions of road more particularly described in section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
