THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8377

A BYLAW to expropriate certain real property to establish a highway $\begin{tabular}{ll} \end{tabular} \label{eq:continuous}$

WHEREAS Council may by bylaw establish, widen, alter, relocate or divert a highway or any portion of a highway.

AND WHEREAS for such purpose Council may by bylaw enter on, expropriate, break up, take or enter into possession of and use any real property in any way necessary or convenient therefor without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS the real property hereinafter described is required to establish a highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BYLAW NO. 1, 1985.
- 2. Council does hereby expropriate for the purpose of establishing a highway, without the consent of the owners thereof but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act, that parcel of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as

Lot 2 of Lot "C", Block 13 of District Lot 153, Group 1, Plan 4991, New Westminster District (hereinafter called "the said land") and Council is hereby authorized and empowered to enter on, break up, take or enter into possession of and use the said lands in any way necessary or convenient for the aforesaid purpose.

- 3. This Bylaw shall before coming into effect be published once in the British Columbia Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia.
- 4. A certified copy of this Bylaw shall be filed in the Land Title Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.
