THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8418

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain lands and improvements pursuant to section 399(3) of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS in the opinion of Council certain lands and improvements would qualify for exemption from taxation but for a secondary use;

AND WHEREAS such secondary use consists of the use of a portion of the improvements for residential purposes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BYLAW NO. 11, 1985.
- 2. Pursuant to section 399(3) of the Municipal Act, the Council does hereby for the year 1986 exempt from taxation under the said Act, except for charges under sections 612(1)(a) and (c), 614, 640 and 641(1)(a), (b) and (c) thereof, the following lands and improvements, namely:

4040 Canada Way (ROLL NO. 1770-4040), owned and used by AGA KHAN FOUNDATION CANADA, and more particularly described as Lot 130, District Lot 68, Group 1, Plan 63012, New Westminster District, SAVE AND EXCEPT that portion of the improvements used for residential purposes and a proportionate area of the land.

READ a first time this 12th day of 1985. AUGUST READ a second time this 12th day of 1985. AUGUST READ a third time this 12th day of 1985. AUGUST Reconsidered and adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members of Council this 14th day of AUGUST 1985.
