

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8456

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 6253, being
the Burnaby Bicycle Licensing
Bylaw 1973

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS
as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY BICYCLE LICENSING
BYLAW 1973, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1985.

2. Section 3 of Bylaw No. 6747 is repealed and the
following substituted therefor:

"3. (1) Every person within the Municipality who owns a bicycle
used on a highway:

- (a) shall have a valid and subsisting licence for the
said bicycle;
- (b) shall procure the said licence upon application in
writing to the Licence Inspector and upon paying
therefor the prescribed fee of \$3.00;
- (c) shall obtain the said licence on or before the
second day of January in each calendar year.

(2) The said prescribed fee of \$3.00 shall not be payable
where the bicycle has been imprinted with an identification number
under the Community Counter-Crime Program.

(3) The said licence when issued shall be for the current
calendar year."

3. Subsection (3) of section 4 of Bylaw No. 6747 is
repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"4. (3) If a licence issued with respect to any bicycle is lost, destroyed or damaged so that same is illegible, the owner of said bicycle shall forthwith make application to the Licence Inspector for a new licence and shall pay the prescribed fee of \$1.00."

5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the first day of January, 1986.
