

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8514

A BYLAW to authorize the construction of
certain local improvement works
on the initiative plan

WHEREAS notice of intention of the Council to undertake the construction, as a local improvement, of the works hereinafter described as been duly given by publication of the notice and by service of it upon the owners of the parcels liable to be specially charged.

AND WHEREAS the Clerk has filed a statutory declaration proving publication and service of the said notice.

AND WHEREAS no petition against the said works signed by a majority of the owners, representing at least one-half of the land value of the parcels liable to be specially charged, has been presented.

AND WHEREAS Council has had prepared the report required by Section 662 of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS the lifetime of the said works is twenty years.

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the said works is \$200,000.

AND WHEREAS the share or portion of the cost of the said works which should be borne by the parcels of land which abut or are deemed to abut on the said works is \$102,511.64.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation's share or proportion of the cost of the said works is \$97,488.36.

AND WHEREAS the special charges should be made payable in ten annual instalments.

AND WHEREAS the total amount proposed to be borrowed under this Bylaw, namely \$200,000, does not exceed the total amount of borrowing approved by the Inspector of Municipalities for local improvement purposes less the amount already borrowed under such authorization.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CONSTRUCTION BYLAW NO. 13, 1986.

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to construct as a local improvement under the provisions of Part 16 of the Municipal Act all necessary equipment, wires, and works, including standards and underground conduits, for the purpose of supplying public lighting for the following streets:
 - (a) Burnlake Drive from Government Street to WPL Lot 101 (8234) and Lot 102 (8245) Burnlake Drive
 - (b) Forglen Drive from Bond Street to Royal Oak Avenue
 - (c) Neville Street from Curragh Avenue to Gilley Avenue
 - (d) Howard Avenue from lane south of Tye Court to Halifax Street
 - (e) Grosvenor Avenue and Grosvenor Crescent from Cambridge Street to Ranelagh Avenue
 - (f) Holdom Avenue from Dundas Street to Bessborough Drive
 - (g) Liberty Place from Penzance Drive south to cul-de-sac
 - (h) Warwick Avenue from Pandora Street to Dundas Street
 - (i) Warwick Avenue from Dundas Street to Cambridge Street
 - (j) Pearl Avenue from Irving Street to Oakland Street

- (k) Yeovil Place and Woodvale Drive from Yeovil Avenue to SPL Lot 252 (2137) and Lot 254 (2138) Woodvale Drive
- (l) Sanders Street from Marlborough Avenue to Royal Oak Avenue
- (m) Marlborough Avenue from Sanders Street south to lane south of Sanders
- (n) Fourteenth Avenue from Canada Way to Sixth Street
- (o) Broadway from Springer Avenue to Holdom Avenue
- (p) Atlee Avenue from Spruce Street to Monarch Street
- (q) Hyde Street from Godwin Avenue west to cul-de-sac
- (r) Rosewood Street from Canada Way to Fourth Street
- (s) Forest Street from Littlewood Avenue east to EPL's Lot 342 (5450) and Lot 344 (5455) Forest Street

3. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized and empowered to cause a contract for the construction of the said works to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of Council to be declared by resolution.

4. The special charges shall be paid by ten annual instalments.

5. The Assessor shall forthwith prepare a frontage tax assessment roll in respect of the said works pursuant to Section 483 of the Municipal Act and in accordance with the provisions of Bylaw No. 6828, as amended, and shall from time to time revise the said frontage tax assessment roll in accordance with subsection (3) of the said Section 483.
