

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8624

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies
in the Capital Works, Machinery and
Equipment Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the
Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter
called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No.
7256 of \$27,167,795.50 as at the 13th day of July, 1986,
calculated as follows:

Balance in Fund at January 1, 1986	\$34,513,000.38
Add: Additions to the fund including interest earned for the current year to date	<u>\$ 6,274,395.12</u>
	\$40,787,395.50
Less: Total expenditure bylaws for the current year to date	<u>13,619,600.00</u>
Balance in Reserve	<u>\$27,167,795.50</u>

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend
\$1,500,000.00 of the said balance for the design and construction
of the Burnaby Village Museum expansion (hereinafter called "the
said works").

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Minister of Municipal
Affairs has been obtained.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS,
MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 5,
1986.

2. The sum of \$1,500,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the design and construction of the Burnaby Village Museum expansion.

3. Should any of the said sum of \$1,500,000.00 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
