

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8666

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 6191, being  
Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound and  
Animal Regulation Bylaw 1972

The Council of The Corporation of the District of  
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND  
ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW 1972, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1986.

2. Section 3(1) of Bylaw No. 8455 is repealed and the  
following substituted therefor:

"3. (1) Every person within the Municipality who owns a dog  
shall

- (a) have a valid and subsisting licence for the said  
dog;
- (b) procure the said licence upon application in  
writing to the Licence Inspector of the Corporation  
upon the form provided and upon paying the  
prescribed licence fee, namely:

- (i) for each unneutered male dog ..... \$29.00
- (ii) for each neutered male dog ..... \$11.50
- (iii) for each unspayed female dog ..... \$29.00
- (iv) for each spayed female dog ..... \$11.50"

3. Section 3 (4) of the said Bylaw is repealed and the  
following substituted therefor:

"(4) Every person who has obtained a licence for an  
unneutered male dog or unspayed female dog and paid  
therefor the fee specified herein shall, before the  
expiration of the licence period and within six months  
of the purchase of the licence, upon presenting a  
certificate in writing from a licenced and qualified

veterinarian certifying that the dog for which the said licence was issued has been neutered or spayed, be entitled to a refund of \$17.50."

4. Clause (c) of section 5 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(c) The penalty for a violation of clause (a) of section 5 shall be \$30.00 if the dog is licensed and \$48.00 plus licence fee if the dog is unlicensed."

5. Schedule "A" is amended by striking out items (1) and (2) and substituting therefor the following:

"(1) For each licensed dog ..... \$30.00  
(2) For each unlicensed dog ..... \$48.00 plus  
licence fee"

6. Schedule "B" is amended by:

(a) striking out item (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"(1) For each dog ..... \$5.25 per day  
or part of a day"

(b) striking out item (4) thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"(4) For any animal not listed  
in (1), (2) and (3) ..... \$2.25 per day  
or part of a day"

7. Item (4) of Schedule "C" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(4) Notwithstanding anything in this schedule contained, licensed veterinarians and other agencies approved by Council shall pay for the disposal of animals and poultry ..... \$.21 per pound  
min. charge of \$5.25"

(5) For each dead body of a cat or dog ..... \$.21 per pound  
min. charge of \$5.25"


8. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st  
day of January 1987.
