

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8818

A BYLAW to dedicate certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for the purpose of a public park at Barnet Beach

WHEREAS section 533 of the Municipal Act empowers the council of a municipality, with the assent of the electors, to dedicate for a public purpose real property owned by the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:


1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY PARK DEDICATION BYLAW 1987.
2. There is hereby dedicated for park and recreation uses of the public that real property owned by the municipality and more particularly described as follows:

Lot 3 of District Lot 214 and Tidal Lands Fronting District Lot 214, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 49510; and

Lot 1 of District Lot 214 and Tidal Lands Fronting District Lot 214, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 49510 EXCEPT that portion of the said Lot 1 containing .6790 hectares (6,792 square metres) more or less shown outlined on the Plan of Leasehold prepared by Ian C. MacDonald, B.C.L.S., dated April 8, 1986 and deposited at the Land Title Office in New Westminster under No. 72797.
