BYLAW NO. 8917

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 6191, being Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound and Animal Regulation Bylaw 1972

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW 1972, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1987.
- 2. Section 3(1) of Bylaw No. 8666 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "3.(1) Every person within the Municipality who owns a dog shall
 - (a) have a valid and subsisting licence for the said dog;
 - (b) procure the said licence upon application in writing to the Licence Inspector of the Corporation upon the form provided and upon paying the prescribed licence fee, namely:
 - (i) for each unneutered male dog \$30.00
 - (ii) for each neutered male dog \$12.00
 - (iii) for each unspayed female dog \$30.00
 - (iv) for each spayed female dog \$12.00"
- 3. Clause (c) of section 5 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "(c) The penalty for a violation of clause (a) of section 5 shall be \$31.00 if the dog is licensed and \$49.50 plus licence fee if the dog is unlicensed."
- 4. Schedule "A" is amended by striking out items (1) and (2) and substituting therefor the following:

	"(1)	For each licensed dog \$31.00
	(2)	For each unlicensed dog \$49.50 plus licence fee"
5.		Schedule "B" is amended by:
	(a)	striking out item (1) thereof and substituting therefor
	the	following:
		"(1) For each dog \$5.40 per day or part of a day"
	(b)	striking out item (4) thereof and substituting therefor
	the	following:
		"(4) For any animal not listed in (1), (2) and (3)

- 6. Item (4) of Schedule "C" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "(4) Notwithstanding anything in this schedule contained, licensed veterinarians and other agencies approved by Council shall pay for the disposal of animals and poultry \$.22 per pound min. charge of \$5.40
 - (5) For each dead body of a cat or dog \$.22 per pound min. charge of \$5.40"
- 7. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January, 1988.
