BYLAW NO. 8922

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 1914, being the Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine Bylaw 1946

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY AUTOMATIC VENDING MACHINE BYLAW 1946, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1987.
- 2. Subsection (1) of section 8A of Bylaw No. 1914, as enacted by Bylaw No. 8663, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "8A.(1) The fee payable for a licence under this Bylaw shall be:
 - for a newpaper vending machine \$24.50 (a)
 - (b) for a coin-operated washer, dryer or dry-cleaning machine located in residential premises containing more than 2 dwelling units \$13.00
 - (c) for a machine that sells goods or services for 25 cents or less
 - (d) for an amusement or recreation vending machine \$53.50
 - (e) for any machine offering goods or services for sale by use of a credit card \$53.00"
- This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January 1988.
