

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 8998

A BYLAW to provide for an annual indemnity  
for the Mayor and Aldermen

WHEREAS the Council may by Bylaw provide for the paying out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Aldermen, and the indemnity of the Mayor may be greater than for the other members of Council;

AND WHEREAS such Bylaw may provide that a portion of the remuneration to be made to the Mayor or to an Alderman shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY COUNCIL INDEMNITY BYLAW 1988.

2. There shall be paid to the Mayor out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity of \$53,423 and one-third of the said annual indemnity shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.

3. There shall be paid to each Alderman out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity of \$14,308 and one-third of the said annual indemnity shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.

4. Bylaw No. 8668 is repealed.

5. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January 1988.
