BYLAW NO. 9039

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$34,415,270.80 as at the 12th day of June, 1988, calculated as follows:

Balance in Fund at January 1, 1988 (Uncommitted)	\$35,078,745.08
Add: Additions to the fund including interest earned for the current	
year to date	1,977,525.72
Less: Total expenditure bylaws for	\$37,056,270.80
the current year to date	2,641,000.00
Balance (Uncommitted)	\$34,415,270.80

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$678,700 of the said balance for Brantford Park development completion, George Green Park playground upgrading, Phillips Avenue North park development, Ron McLean Park playground upgrading, Riverway Sports Complex washroom and changeroom addition and Hart House landscaping and parking lot construction (hereinafter called "the said Works").

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS,
MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 6,
1988.

2. The sum of \$678,700 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said Works.

3. Should any of the said sum of \$678,700 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
