BYLAW NO. 9105

A BYLAW to amend BURNABY INDEMNIFICATION  
BYLAW 1976

The Council of The Corporation of the District of  
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY INDEMNIFICATION  
BYLAW 1976, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1988.
  
2. Section 2 of Burnaby Indemnification Bylaw 1976 is  
amended by adding the words "and member of Council" after the  
words "every officer and employee".
  
3. Section 3 of the said Bylaw is repealed and the  
following substituted therefor:  
  
"3. The Council shall not seek indemnity against  
any officer, employee or member of Council where  
an action of the officer, employee or member of  
Council results in a claim for damages against  
the municipality by a third party unless the said  
officer, employee or member has been grossly  
negligent or has acted contrary to the terms and  
conditions of his employment or to an order given  
to him by a person in authority over him."
