BYLAW NO. 9109

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 4742, being Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965,
AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 79, 1988.

2. Item (15) of section 403.1 of Schedule Number VI of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

- "(15) The following additional uses in areas having an M3a designation:
 - (a) Automobile wrecking yards, and junk yards, provided that the use
 - (i) is located at least 30 m (98.43 feet)from the boundary of any A2, R or RM zoning district,
 - (ii) is completely enclosed by a solid fence or wall that is 2.4 m (7.87 feet) high and is uniformly painted and well maintained and is not used for advertising or display purposes or for the posting of notices, and

(iii) is separated from any adjoining street or from any directly abutting A2, R or RM zoning district by a strip of land not less than 1.8 m (5.91 feet) in width and has the required solid fence or wall located on the interior or rear side of the strip, which shall be suitably landscaped and properly maintained;

- (b) Pounds, provided that all buildings, structures, cages, pens or runs associated with the use are located at a distance not less than 24.5 m (80.38 feet) from all street or lot lines;
- (c) The storage of low hazard fireworks for recreation, which are included in Class 7.2.1 of the classification of fireworks under the Canada Explosives Act and Regulations."
