BYLAW NO. 9191

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies  
in the Capital Works, Machinery and  
Equipment Reserve Fund



WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the  
Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter  
called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw  
No. 7256 of \$33,569,783.64 as at the 19th day of March, 1989,  
including \$405,942 in the Metrotown Parking Facilities Account;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$8,106,942  
of the said balance for the design and construction of the  
Metrotown Civic Facilities, including the library, civic square,  
public parking and major roads (hereinafter called "the said  
works");

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the  
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS,  
MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 3,  
1989.
2. The sum of \$8,106,942, including \$405,942 from the  
Metrotown Parking Facilities Account, is hereby appropriated from  
the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.
3. Should any of the said sum of \$8,106,942 remain  
unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been  
made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of  
the said Reserve Fund.
