BYLAW NO. 9192

A BYLAW to increase the number of licensed taxi cabs licensed to operate in Burnaby

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAB AND COMMERCIAL
VEHICLES BYLAW 1951, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1989.

2. Section 1(b) of BURNABY CAB AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES BYLAW 1951 is amended by adding thereto, immediately after "Class G" definition, the following:

> "Class 'H' wheel chair accessible taxi cab means a taxi cab that is equipped with a ramp or other equipment for loading and unloading a person in a wheelchair, and has a seating capacity of not more than six passengers including at least one passenger in a wheelchair."

3. Section 3 of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"3. The number of taxi cab licences granted under this Bylaw shall not exceed one hundred two (102) of which six shall be in respect of wheel chair accessible taxi cabs."

4. Section 62 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately after subsection (3), the following subsection:

"(4) Every driver of a wheelchair accessible taxi cab shall, notwithstanding subsection (1), give priority to a request for service by a person in a wheelchair."
