A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$24,104,566.46 as at the 16th day of April, 1989, calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$907,035 of the said balance for Augusta Park development, Cariboo Park playground development, Central Park playground development, Forest Glen Park playground development, Forest Grove Park fieldhouse construction, Lochdale Park playground development, Parkcrest Park playground development, Powerhouse Park development, Squid Lake Park sportsfield construction and Warner Loat Park washroom replacement (hereinafter called "the said works").

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS,
 MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 6,
 1989.
- 2. The sum of \$907,035 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.
- 3. Should any of the said sum of \$907,035 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
