A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$24,360,341.60 as at the 14th day of May, 1989, calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$97,272 of the said balance for the purchase of materials for the Corporation's share of the cost to underground existing overhead wiring in the 7000 block of 17th Avenue and 18th Avenue, the 4400 block of Buchanan Street and the 1900 block of Rosser Avenue (hereinafter called "the said works").

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS,
MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 11,
1989.

- 2. The sum of \$97,272 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.
- 3. Should any of the said sum of \$97,272 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
