BYLAW NO. 9243

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain lands
and improvements pursuant to section
400(2) of the Municipal Act

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION
BYLAW NO. 10, 1989.

2. Pursuant to section 400(2) of the Municipal Act, Council
does hereby exempt from taxation under section 273(a), (b) and
(c) of the said Act for the year 1990 for fifty percent of the
following lands and improvements acquired or held by the Board of
School Trustees of School District No. 41 (Burnaby) and used or
occupied as licensee or tenant by a non-profit organization,
namely:

(1) Sussex School - 4443 Irmin Street (Roll No. 3380-4443)
more particularly described as Lot 24 N.1/2 Except S.33
feet, District Lot 99, Group 1, New Westminster
District, Plan 844 and 2192 and Lots 1 and 7 to 12,
Block 23, District Lot 99, Group 1, New Westminster
District, Plan 2192, occupied by Canadiana Costume
Society.

(2) Riverway West School - 4340 Carson Street (Roll No.
3600-4340) more particularly described as Lot 2 Except
Explanatory Plan 14533, District Lot 156, Group 1, New
Westminster District, Plan 1030, occupied by:

(a) Greater Vancouver Childbirth Education
Association Society

- (b) Women's Skills Development Workshop
 - (c) Public Education for Peace
- (3) Glenwood School - 5787 Marine Drive (Roll No. 3700-5787)
more particularly described as 1.03 acres of District

- (4) Burnaby Heights School - 250 S. Willingdon Avenue (Roll
