

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9251

A BYLAW to dispose of a certain portions of  
highway in exchange for other lands

WHEREAS pursuant to section 574 of the Municipal Act R.S.B.C. 1979 the Council may by bylaw dispose of any portion of a highway in exchange for such lands as may be necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway.

AND WHEREAS all deeds executed under this section have effect as a Crown grant, free of all rights of way, and all lands taken in exchange for any portion of a highway under this section are public highways, and the title thereto is vested in the Crown.

AND WHEREAS the Council, before adopting this Bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic those portions of highway more particularly hereinafter described for the purpose of relocating and diverting a highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY HIGHWAY EXCHANGE BYLAW NO. 10, 1989.

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to stop up and close to traffic ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as all those portions of road in

- (a) Westerly 33 Feet of Block 17, District Lot 83, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to Filing 29758; containing 0.1639 ha.;
- (b) Easterly 33 Feet of Block 18, District Lot 83, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to Filing 29758; containing 0.2134 ha.;
- (c) Portion of Blocks 8 and 9, District Lot 79, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to Filing 40234; containing 0.2029 ha., and
- (d) District Lot 79, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 2547 containing 788.5 m<sup>2</sup>

(hereinafter called "the said closed portions of road") and shown hatched on Reference Plan prepared by R.E. Petersen, B.C.L.S., deposited in the Land Title Office under Number \_\_\_\_\_, a copy of which is hereunto annexed (hereinafter called "the said plan").


3. The Council is further authorized and empowered to grant and convey the said closed portions of lane unto the registered owners of:


- (a) Lot "C" Except Firstly: part subdivided by Plan 43117, Secondly: part subdivided by Plan 48395, District Lot 83, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 19419, and

(b) Lot 82, District Lots 80 and 83, Group 1, New  
Westminster District, Plan 25720

(hereinafter called "the said lots") in exchange for those portions of the said lots containing 0.3709 ha. and 590.0 m<sup>2</sup>, respectively, shown outlined on the said plan, and those portions of the said lots shall, upon deposit of the necessary transfers in the Land Title Office, be public highway and title thereto shall be vested in the Crown.
