

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9260

A BYLAW to dispose of a certain portions of
highway in exchange for other lands

WHEREAS pursuant to section 574 of the Municipal Act R.S.B.C. 1979 the Council may by bylaw dispose of any portion of a highway in exchange for such lands as may be necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway.

AND WHEREAS all deeds executed under this section have effect as a Crown grant, free of all rights of way, and all lands taken in exchange for any portion of a highway under this section are public highways, and the title thereto is vested in the Crown.

AND WHEREAS the Council, before adopting this Bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic those portions of highway more particularly hereinafter described for the purpose of relocating and diverting a highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY HIGHWAY EXCHANGE BYLAW NO. 12, 1989.

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to stop up and close to traffic ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as all those portions of road and lane in:

(a) District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 992, containing 279.8 m², and;

(b) District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 13338, containing 499.7 m²

(hereinafter called "the said closed portions of road and lane") and shown hatched on Reference Plan prepared by Mike E. Shaw, B.C.L.S., deposited in the Land Title Office under Number _____, a copy of which is hereunto annexed (hereinafter called "the said plan").

3. The Council is further authorized and empowered to grant and convey the said closed portions of road and lane unto the registered owners of:

(a) Lot 9, Block 4, District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 992, containing 164.8 m²;

(b) Lot 8, Except: Firstly: portion .05 of an acre more or less as shown on sketch deposited 1440F, Secondly: Parcel "A" (Reference Plan 4343), Block 4, District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 992, containing 535.9 m²; and

(c) Lot 7, Except: Firstly: Parcel "C" (Reference Plan 4558), Secondly: Parcel "B" (Reference Plan 23433),

Block 4, District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster
District, Plan 992, containing 347.2 m²


(hereinafter called "the said lots") in exchange for those portions of the said lots shown outlined on the said plan, and those portions of the said lots shall, upon deposit of the necessary transfers in the Land Title Office, be public highway and title thereto shall be vested in the Crown.
