

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9314

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 1914, being the Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine Bylaw 1946

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY AUTOMATIC VENDING MACHINE BYLAW 1946, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1989.

2. Subsection (1) of section 8A of Bylaw No. 1914, as enacted by Bylaw No. 8922, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"8A.(1) The fee payable for a licence under this Bylaw shall be:

- (a) for a newspaper vending machine \$26.75
- (b) for a coin-operated washer, dryer or dry-cleaning machine located in residential premises containing more than 2 dwelling units \$14.20
- (c) for a machine that sells goods or services
 - for 25 cents or less \$8.15
 - for more than 25 cents and less than 76 cents \$26.75
 - for more than 75 cents \$31.00
- (d) for an amusement or recreation vending machine \$58.25
- (e) for any machine offering goods or services for sale by use of a credit card \$57.75"

3. This Bylaw shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1990.
