

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9318

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 3089, being the  
Burnaby Trades Licence Bylaw 1950

The Council of The Corporation of the District of  
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TRADES LICENCE BYLAW  
1950, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1989.

2. Section 1 of BURNABY TRADES LICENCE BYLAW 1950 is  
repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"1.(1) This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY BUSINESS LICENCE  
BYLAW.

(2) In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires,

(a) 'arcade' means any premises or portion thereof  
where the principal activity is the operation of  
six or more automatic vending machines used for  
recreation or amusement;

(b) 'builder' means a person who, as a business  
enterprise, constructs or erects or causes to be  
constructed or erected, a house, building or other  
structure;

(c) 'cart' means a table, wagon or other structure  
from which merchandise other than food that  
requires a food handler's permit is offered for

sale, and that is located at an approved site within an enclosed shopping mall but is not affixed to the site;

(d) 'contractor' means any person who undertakes to perform work upon an improvement or to furnish materials for an improvement, but who does not occupy or operate his business from commercial or industrial property in the municipality;

(e) 'dry cleaning and laundry plant' does not include a place that serves only as a drop-off and pick-up depot;

(f) 'employee' means a person who is employed on a full-time, part-time or temporary basis;

(g) 'hawker, peddler, huckster' means a person who sells or offers for sale goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuff or other article or thing to be immediately delivered to the customer;

(h) 'home craft' means the following home occupations as defined by Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965:

- (i) artist or writer,
- (ii) dressmaker or seamstress,
- (iii) musician or music teacher,
- (iv) persons engaged in home crafts or hobbies;

(i) 'improvement' includes anything made, constructed, erected, built, altered, repaired or added to, in, upon or under land and attached thereto or intended to become part thereof, and also any clearing, excavating, digging, drilling, tunnelling, filling, grading or ditching of, in, upon or under land;

(j) 'Inspector' means the Tax and Licence Director of the Corporation or other employee designated to grant business licences;

(k) 'junk' means any old or used article or thing including old or used automobiles, automobile parts, barrels, building material, bottles, cans, cardboard, drums, engines and engine parts, glass, industrial material, jars, kegs, machinery, machinery parts, metal, paper, rags, ropes, rubber, waste, vats and similar containers;

(l) 'junk dealer' means a person who carries on, maintains, owns or operates the business, trade, occupation or calling of purchasing, selling or storing junk and includes a person who carries on, maintains, owns or operates a junk store, junk shop or junk yard;

(m) 'multiple unit accommodation' means any building containing three or more rental dwelling or sleeping units, including a motel, hotel, apartment building or other residential premises;

(n) 'person' has the meaning ascribed to it by the Interpretation Act;

(o) 'personal care facility: adult nursing home' means a community care facility as defined by the Community Care Facility Act that provides personal care to three or more adults;

(p) 'personal care facility: childcare' means a community care facility as defined by the Community

Care Facility Act that provides personal care to three or more children;

(q) 'personal service establishment' means a barber shop, beauty parlour, suntan studio, tattoo parlour, manicure parlour or other establishment that provides personal grooming services;

(r) 'restaurant' means a place where food or drink is prepared and offered for sale to the public for consumption on the premises;

(s) 'room' does not include a bathroom; and a dining room combined with either a living room or a kitchen shall be deemed to be two rooms;

(t) 'salesagent' means a person who sells, solicits, offers for sale or takes orders for

(i) any goods, wares, foodstuff or other thing to be afterwards delivered to the customer, or

(ii) any service to be afterwards performed at the customer's premises or elsewhere;

(u) 'telephone communications facility' includes radio, television and any other communication facility."

3. Clauses (e) and (f) of section 7 of the said Bylaw are repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(e) The fee payable in respect of any transfer of licence from one person to another is twenty-five dollars."

4. The said Bylaw is further amended by adding thereto, immediately after section 7, the following section:

"8.(1) Any person, before changing his place of business, shall obtain a transfer of his licence.

(2) The fee for a transfer of licence under this section shall be the amount owing for a new licence as set forth in Schedule "A" less the amount listed as a renewal fee."

5. Section 28 of the said Bylaw is repealed.

6. Schedule "A" of the said Bylaw is repealed and the attached Schedule "A" is substituted therefor.


7. This Bylaw shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1990.
