BYLAW NO. 9328

A BYLAW to increase parking fines

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BYLAW 1961, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 4, 1989.
2. Subsection (1) of Section 18A of Burnaby Street and Traffic Bylaw 1961 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"18A. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of this Bylaw, every person who

(a) violates section 13(7) of this Bylaw shall pay a fine of \$15.00 but if the fine is paid on or postmarked within five days from the date of the violation the fine shall be \$8.00;


(b) violates any provision of this Bylaw regulating, controlling or prohibiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles shall pay a fine of \$25.00 but if the fine is paid or postmarked within five days from the date of the violation the fine shall be \$15.00."


