BYLAW NO. 9328

A BYLAW to increase parking fines

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BYLAW 1961, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 4, 1989.
- 2. Subsection (1) of Section 18A of Burnaby Street and Traffic Bylaw 1961 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "18A. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of this Bylaw, every person who
 - (a) violates section 13(7) of this Bylaw shall pay a fine of \$15.00 but if the fine is paid on or postmarked within five days from the date of the violation the fine shall be \$8.00;
 - (b) violates any provision of this Bylaw regulating, controlling or prohibiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles shall pay a fine of \$25.00 but if the fine is paid or postmarked within five days from the date of the violation the fine shall be \$15.00."
