BYLAW NO. 9353

A BYLAW to remove the reservation for park purposes placed upon certain lands situated at Regent Street west of Gilmore Avenue.

WHEREAS by Bylaw No. 748 adopted by Council on the 6th day of August, 1928 and lodged in the Land Title Office at New Westminster under No. D.F. 14556, certain lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, were set apart for park purposes;


AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and in the public interest to remove the said reservation from a portion of the said lands;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY PARK RESERVATION REMOVAL BYLAW 1990.
2. The Council does hereby remove the reservation imposed by Bylaw No. 748, for park purposes from Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 19, District Lot 69, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1321 now legally described as Lot 1, District Lot 69, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 80081.
