## BYLAW NO. 9362

## A BYLAW to require dog owners to remove dog excrement

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1990.
- 2. BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW is amended by adding thereto, immediately after section 5, the following section:
  - "5A. (1) In this section "owner" means every person who possesses, has charge of or harbours a dog.
  - (2) Every owner of a dog that leaves or deposits excrement on any property other than property of the owner shall immediately remove such excrement and dispose of it on her or his own property."
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into force on the 1st day of February, 1991.
