BYLAW NO. 9362

A BYLAW to require dog owners to remove
dog excrement

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND
ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1990.

2. BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW is
amended by adding thereto, immediately after section 5, the
following section:

"5A. (1) In this section "owner" means every person who
possesses, has charge of or harbours a dog.

(2) Every owner of a dog that leaves or deposits
excrement on any property other than property of the owner
shall immediately remove such excrement and dispose of it on
her or his own property."



3. This Bylaw shall come into force on the 1st day of
February, 1991.
