BYLAW NO. 9379

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of surplus
in the Waterworks Sinking Fund Account

WHEREAS there is a surplus in the Waterworks Sinking
Fund Account of \$346,495.52 as at the 18th day of March 1990;

AND WHEREAS the debt authorized by Burnaby Waterworks
Bylaw No. 4086 has been repaid;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend the said
surplus for watermain renewals and other waterwork projects
(hereinafter called "the said works");

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY WATERWORKS SINKING
FUND SURPLUS APPROPRIATION BYLAW 1990.

2. The sum of \$346,495.52 is hereby appropriated from the
Waterworks Sinking Fund Account to be expended for the said
works.
