BYLAW NO. 9414

A BYLAW acquire and dedicate certain land for highway purposes

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BYLAW NO. 1, 1990.

2. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient transfer in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, and for good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as that portion of Lot 1, District Lot 125, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 70850 containing 0.2025 ha., shown outlined on the Reference Plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 17th day of May, 1990, deposited in the Land Title Office under Number _____, a copy of which is hereto annexed.

3. Upon deposit of the said transfer in fee simple in the Land Title Office at New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the lands therein described shall be established as a public highway.
