BYLAW NO. 9439

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain lands  
and improvements pursuant to section  
400(2) of the Municipal Act

The Council of The Corporation of the District of  
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BYLAW NO. 10, 1990.
  
2. Pursuant to section 400(2) of the Municipal Act, Council does hereby exempt from taxation under section 273(a), (b) and (c) of the said Act for the year 1991 for fifty percent of the following lands and improvements acquired or held by the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 41 (Burnaby) and used or occupied as licensee or tenant by a non-profit organization, namely:
  - (1) Glenwood School - 5787 Marine Drive (Roll No. 3700-5787) more particularly described as 1.03 acres of District Lot 159, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1219, occupied by Institute of Communications Art Association.
  
  - (2) Burnaby Heights School - 250 S. Willingdon Avenue (Roll No. 5655-0250) more particularly described as Lot 65, District Lot 122, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 51029, occupied by:
    - (a) B.C. Parents in Crisis
    - (b) Burnaby Unemployment Action Centre
    - (c) Carpentry Apprenticeship, Joint Board of B.C.

- (3) Royal Oak School - 6037 Marlborough Avenue (Roll No. 5965-6037) more particularly described as Lot 118, District Lot 32, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 34019, occupied by Columbia College.


