A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

- 3. Should any of the said sum of \$221,700 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
