

BYLAW NO. 9462

A BYLAW to reserve lands owned by the Municipality of Burnaby for park purposes

WHEREAS the council of a district municipality may by bylaw reserve for a particular municipal or other public purpose any land owned by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is a district municipality;

AND WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described are owned by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

 This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY PARKS RESERVATION BYLAW 1990.

2. The Council hereby reserves for public park purposes that portion of Lot 1, District Lot 96, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan ______ containing 0.6878 ha., shown outlined in heavy black line on Explanatory Plan prepared by M. Schulze, B.C.L.S., dated August 21, 1990, copy of which is hereunto annexed.
