BYLAW NO. 9496

A BYLAW to expropriate certain lands in Burnaby

WHEREAS Council may by bylaw acquire land for a parking lot and a park for community and school purposes;

AND WHEREAS for such purposes Council may by bylaw expropriate real property subject to the provisions of the Expropriation Act;

AND WHEREAS the real property hereinafter described is required for community and school purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BYLAW 1990.

2. Council does hereby expropriate for the said purposes that parcel of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as:

All that portion of Lot 86, District Lot 98, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 40572 containing by admeasurement 0.4942 ha., shown outlined on Reference Plan prepared by R.E. Petersen, B.C.L.S. dated the 12th day of October, 1990 and deposited in the Land Title

Office under No. _____, a copy of
which is annexed hereto.
