A BYLAW to ratify an agreement with the City
of New Westminster for installation
of a traffic signal at 10th Avenue
and Cumberland Street

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY NEW WESTMINSTER
AGREEMENT RATIFICATION BYLAW 1991.
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into an
agreement with the City of New Westminster to share equally in
the cost of installation and maintenance of a traffic signal at
the intersection of 10th Avenue and Cumberland Street at the
boundary between the two municipalities.
3. The Council hereby ratifies the agreement annexed hereto
as Schedule "A".







2. Burnaby agrees to pay New Westminster fifty percent (50%) of the cost of installation and maintenance of the said traffic signal.

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS the Parties desire to share the costs of installation and maintenance of a traffic signal at the intersection of 10th Avenue and Cumberland Street which forms part of the boundary between the two municipalities;

NOW THEREFORE the Parties in consideration of the covenants and agreements contained herein, mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. New Westminster will install a vehicle activated traffic signal at the intersection of 10th Avenue and Cumberland Street in accordance with design prepared by R.P. Shaflick Engineering Ltd. on the 20th day of November, 1990 entitled "Traffic Signal 10th Avenue and Cumberland Street".
