

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9646

A BYLAW to amend Bylaw No. 3065, being the  
Burnaby Club Regulation Bylaw 1950

The Council of The Corporation of the District of  
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CLUB REGULATION BYLAW  
1950, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1991.

2. Section 2 of Bylaw No. 3065, as enacted by Bylaw No.  
9492, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"2. No club shall operate or carry on business unless  
it holds a valid and subsisting licence from the  
municipality. The fee for a first licence shall  
be \$2,542.00 and the fee for a renewal licence  
shall be \$2,252.00."

2. Section 4 of Bylaw No. 3065, as enacted by Bylaw No.  
9492, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"4. Every club carrying on business within the  
municipality shall appoint a manager who shall,  
before entering upon his duties, be in possession  
of a valid and subsisting licence. For a first  
licence the fee shall be \$213.00 and for a renewal  
licence the fee shall be \$88.00."

4. This Bylaw shall come into force on the 1st day of  
January 1992.
