BYLAW NO. 9669

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies  
in the Capital Works, Machinery and  
Equipment Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the  
Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter  
called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw  
No. 7256 of \$63,633,399.37 as at the 3rd day of November, 1991,  
calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$129,500 of  
the said balance for the removal of overhead lines along  
Patterson Avenue from Kingsway to a point approximately 96 metres  
south of Beresford Street (hereinafter called "the said works");

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the  
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS,  
MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 22,  
1991.

2. The sum of \$129,500 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.



3. Should any of the said sum of \$129,500 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
