A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund


WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$42,676,999.49 as at the 1st day of December, 1991, calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$25,000 of the said balance for an environmental site investigation of Corporation and private lands at 4443 Still Creek Street and 2517, 2539 and 2561 Willingdon Avenue (hereinafter called "the said works");

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS,
MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 3,
1992.



3. Should any of the said sum of \$25,000 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
