BYLAW NO. 9702

A BYLAW respecting damage deposits and inspection fees to protect municipal property during construction pursuant to building permits

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS
as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY BUILDING BYLAW 1973, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1992.

2. Paragraph (c) of section 4(2) of Burnaby Building Bylaw 1973 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(c) the applicant has deposited with the Corporation a cash bond in the amount set out in Schedule 'D' of the Bylaw to guarantee payment for damage to or cleanup of municipal works or property occasioned by the construction described in the permit; but the Director Engineering, where he is of the opinion that damage to municipal works or property is unlikely, may waive or reduce the damage deposit;"

3. Appendix "D" of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted therefor:



1. Single or Two Family Dwelling Construction	\$ 50.00	\$1,000
2. Single or Two Family Dwelling Addition or Demolition	50.00	\$500
3. Construction other than Single or Two Family Dwelling	100.00	\$1,000 for 15 m frontage and \$30/m of frontage thereafter
4. Demolition other than Single or Two Family Dwelling	50.00	\$1,000 for 15 m frontage and \$30/m of frontage thereafter
5. Swimming pool installation	50.00	
6. Construction garage or carport	50.00
