THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BYLAW NO. 9733

A BYLAW to expropriate a leasehold interest in certain lands in Burnaby

WHEREAS Council may by bylaw acquire real property and rights in and to it for the construction of a highway;

AND WHEREAS for such purposes Council may by bylaw expropriate real property and rights in and to it subject to the provisions of the Expropriation Act;

AND WHEREAS the real property hereinafter described is required for highway purposes;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is the registered owner of the real property hereinafter described but subject to a lease in favour of Roadmaster Auto Centre Ltd. (formerly Burnaby Engines West Ltd.) for a term ending December 31, 1993.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BYLAW 1992.
- 2. Council does hereby expropriate for the said purposes the leasehold estate and interest of Roadmaster Auto Centre Ltd. in that certain parcel of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as:

Lot "D", District Lot 95, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 18033

pursuant to a written lease made the 20th day of September, 1984.
