BYLAW NO. 9839

A BYLAW to set fees for tax certificates

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:


1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TAX CERTIFICATE FEES BYLAW.
2. In this Bylaw, "tax certificate" means a certificate showing
  - (a) the amount of unpaid taxes charged against specified real property,
  - (b) whether the real property has been sold for taxes, and
  - (c) if the property has been sold for taxes, the time remaining for redemption, if any, and the amount required to redeem it.
3. The fee for a tax certificate shall be \$5.00 if mailed and \$10.00 if sent by electronic facsimile.
